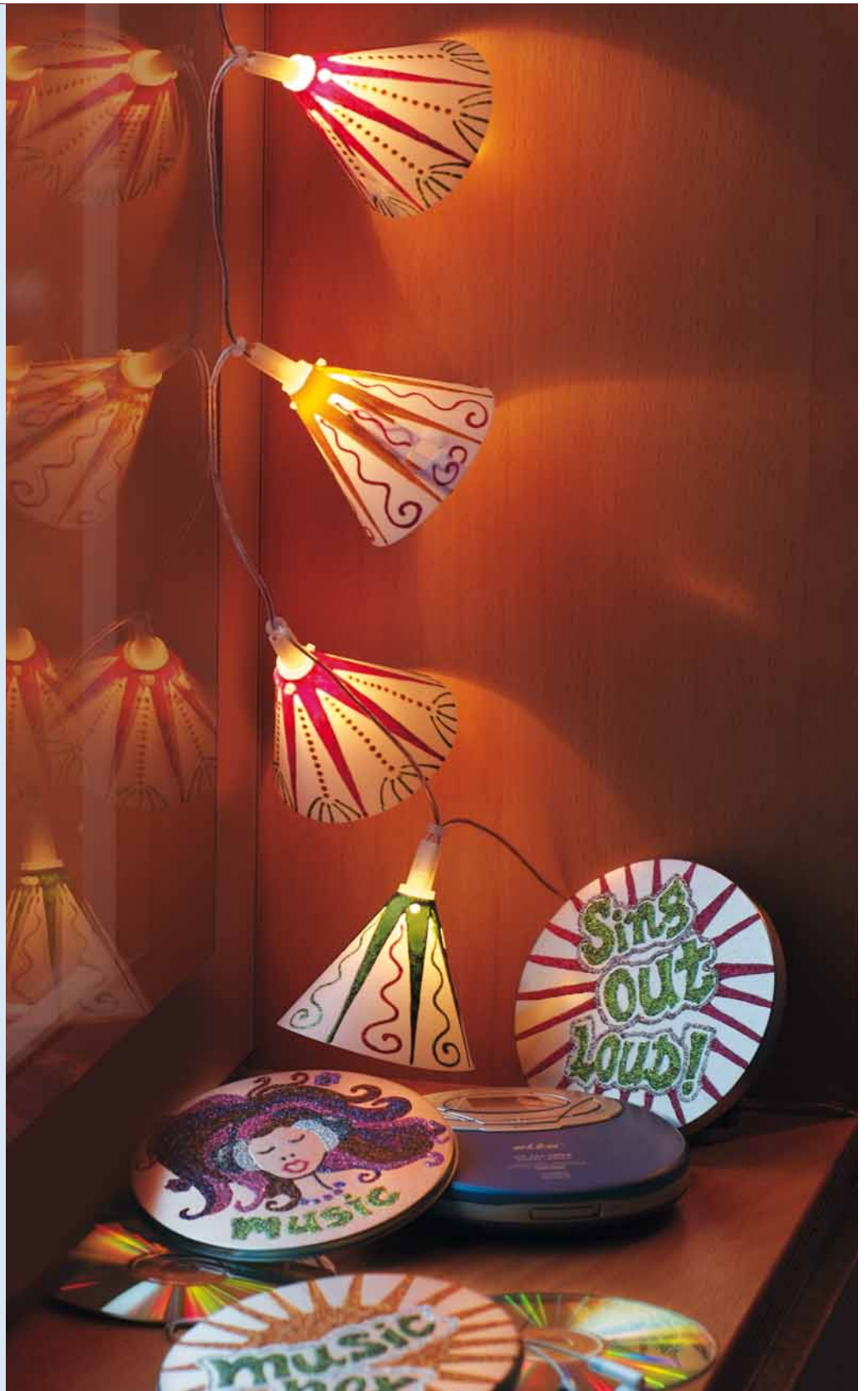

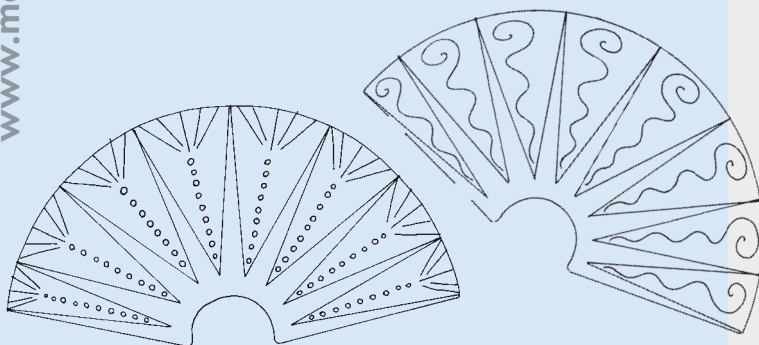


Marabu-Glitter Liners make things shine. Super easy to use, super shiny results!

Degree of difficulty **1** 2 3

To tear off, take away and collect





From Marabu you will need...

- Glitter-Liner in glitter-tangerine (525), glitter-ruby (538), glitter-kiwi (561), glitter-olive (565), glitter-silver (582)

... you will also need:

- transparent adhesive film
- fairy lights with cones

Here's how it's done

1. Photocopy the motif to the desired size (perhaps enlarge), put it under the opened-out cone and fix the edge using adhesive film.
2. Now decorate each cone with Glitter Liners using different colour combinations, e.g. tangerine-ruby, olive-ruby-silver etc. Continue for all the cones, varying the design each time. Glue back together and allow to dry for at least 6 hours, overnight is best.
3. Then remove the patterns and fasten the cones back onto the lightbulbs. Finished.

Variation: painting of CD-covers

Whether it is a tin CD-box (see front page) or the usual transparent CD-cover: even these can be jazzed up very easily using Glitter Liners. Your chosen motif can be traced easily onto tin using a pencil or copied using carbon paper. For transparent covers, simply put your favourite design under the lid and trace. Plenty of ideas are available on the web.

Tips:

- Milky when wet, Glitter-Liner glitters beautifully when dry.
- When painting shake the paint into the liner tip from time to time (liner cap must be on) like you would a thermometer.
- Fabrics of any kind can be decorated with Glitter Liners, (cotton and blended textiles up to a maximum of 20% synthetic fibres, pre-washed, free of finishing and softening agents). Wash-resistant up to 40°C when fixed (gentle wash). Always wash and iron inside out.
