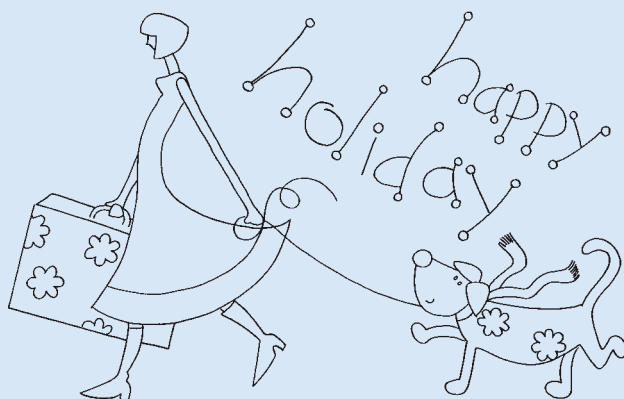


Objects of any kind can be colourfully decorated using the beautiful shimmering Marabu-Metallic Liners – giving them a very personal touch!

Degree of difficulty ① ② ③

To tear off, take away and collect





From Marabu you will need...

- Metallic Liner in metallic-yellow (719), metallic-orange (713), metallic-red (732), metallic-pink (733), metallic-light blue (790), metallic-petrol (792), metallic-violet (750), metallic-olive (765), metallic-brown (746), metallic-graphite (779), metallic-white (770), metallic-copper (787), metallic-silver (782)

... you will also need:

- child's suitcase, e.g. in red
- tracing paper (e.g. carbon-copy paper)
- pencil

Here's how it's done:

1. Photocopy the motif to the desired size (perhaps enlarge). Insert tracing paper between suitcase and pattern (rub-off side must be downwards) and copy all lines without slipping.
2. Then draw all the outlines for the woman, the dog and the dog lead using metallic-silver Liner. Allow to dry.
3. Then paint the coloured areas using the Liners: metallic-pink for the dress; metallic-petrol for the suitcase; metallic-graphite for the hair; metallic-olive for the boots and the dog; metallic-brown for flesh. Dog's booties and scarf get colourful patterns, the nose is painted in metallic-red. The flowers are painted without outlines onto the painted areas of the dress and dog. The writing can be very colourful or just one colour, letters are dotted with metallic-white. Allow everything to dry well.

Tips:

- For colouring larger areas, apply the paint with the Liner first and then spread with a brush if needed.
- For especially fine lines, screw fun & fancy paint tips onto the liner tips (available in 0.3/0.5/0.7/0.9 mm).
- Store the Liner upside down. When painting shake the paint into the liner tip from time to time (liner cap must be on) like you would a thermometer.
