From Marabu you will need...

- Textil Glitter in glitter-sapphire (594), glitter-graphite (579); glitter-white (570), glitter-gold (584), glitter-silver (582)
- Glitter Liner in glitter-graphite (579)
- Textil plus 50 ml in white (070), carmine red (032)
- Forte brush, round No. 1 and flat No. 8

... you will also need:

- 1 photo album with fabric cover (alternatively cover one with fabric yourself)
- carbon paper for fabric

Here's how it's done

1. Photocopy the motif to the desired size (perhaps enlarge). Insert carbon paper between album and pattern (rub-off side must be face down) and copy all lines without slipping. Remove motif and write "Our Wedding" free hand using a light pencil; alternatively design the lettering on a computer, then print out and trace.
2. Mix white and carmine red (Textil plus) to achieve a light pink and paint in the faces. Paint the whites of the eyes with white. Allow to dry.
3. Next paint "Our Wedding" in glitter-gold using a brush. Then the bride using a brush: tiara and pearl necklace in glitter-gold, veil and wedding dress in glitter-white, eyes in glitter-sapphire. Then with the Liner in glitter-graphite, mark the pupils, folds of veil, rolling line for nose and mouth, borders of eyes and eyelashes using the Liner. Allow to dry.
4. Now paint the bridegroom: top-hat and jacket with glitter-graphite from the glass and a brush, bow tie in glitter-gold, colours of eyes in glitter-sapphire. Next use glitter-graphite Liner for pupils, paint shades of bow tie, sweep a line for the nose and mouth and rim of eyes. Allow everything to dry for at least 6 hours, overnight is best. **Fixing:** Iron for 3 min. from the front on cotton setting, covered by a cotton cloth, without using steam. For larger areas, iron for 3 min. per 30 cm. **Tip:** Using Marabu-Textil Glitter, textiles of any kind (cotton and blended textiles up to a maximum of 20 % synthetic fibres, pre-washed, free of finishing and softening agents) can be painted.
