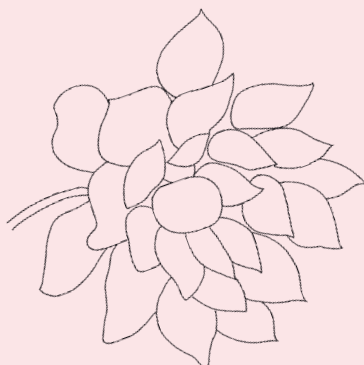


Painting with metallic effects give fabrics a personal touch: this gives a high-quality effect and is easier than you think!

## From Marabu you will need...

- Textil Metallic in metallic-orange (713), metallic-red (732), metallic-olive (765)
- Metallic Liner in metallic-olive (765)
- Textil 50 ml in apricot (025)
- Textil-Collection table runner (102)
- Forte brush, flat, No. 8

## ... you will also need:

- masking tape

## Here's how it's done

1. Cover work surface and lay out the table runner (approx. 130 x 45 cm) smoothly. Mask off a horizontal strip approx. 20 cm high at both narrow ends using masking tape. Divide the resulting rectangle into 5 stripes of equal widths with tape. First paint left, middle and right stripes with metallic-olive. When dry paint the two remaining stripes with metallic-orange. Allow to dry.
2. Next paint dahlias and circles onto the fabric however and wherever you like. Dahlias: Photocopy the motif to the desired size (perhaps enlarge) and put it under the table runner where you want it. It will show through the fabric. Paint every petal in metallic-red using a brush allowing a distance of 1 mm between each petal. As a variant, just paint the outlines of the petals with Metallic Liner. Circles: Draw circles onto paper using plates of different sizes, put the pattern under the fabric and paint circles in different colours, for example: A) Paint in the circle with apricot and paint the outline of the dahlia with metallic-olive Liner into the circle while still wet. B) Paint in the circle with metallic-orange and dab some small dots round the circle using metallic-olive Liner. C) Make a dotted outline around the circle using Metallic Liner. Allow everything to dry well. Drying time approx. 6 hours depending on thickness of application.
3. **Fixing:** Iron each painted area for 3 min. on cotton setting, through a thin cotton cloth. Or fix in a pre-heated oven (150°C) for 8 min. Then wash-resistant up to 40°C (gentle wash). Always wash and iron inside out.
4. **Tip:** Using Marabu-Textil Metallic, textiles of any kind (cotton and blended textiles up to a maximum of 20% synthetic fibres, pre-washed, free of finishing and softening agents) can be painted.
